USING KEYCODES AND UTILITY CODES (ACTIVE ENTRY 1 ONLY)

RESIDENT 6-DIGIT KEYCODES

Residents are assigned a 6-digit, personalized keycode for accessing the facility. To use the keycode assigned, the resident must first push the key once and enter their keycode. The screen will display "Access Granted" (fig a.) and access will be allowed. If an incorrect keycode is entered, the system will inform the user of the invalid entry (fig b.) The resident can then re-enter their keycode.
